



Getting Started Guide for Students

Preparing to study with MyMathLab

Welcome to MyMathLab in CourseCompass. You can use MyMathLab to do your homework and tests online, and you can take advantage of tutorial learning aids (such as step-by-step examples, animations, and videos) when you practice. MyMathLab is designed to help you succeed in your math course.

This guide will help you register for CourseCompass and log into your MyMathLab course. At any time during the process you can click the help icon (🔍) on a page to get detailed information on using that page.

Before you begin

Before you try to register for MyMathLab, be sure you have:

- A valid **e-mail address**
- The MyMathLab **Course ID** from your instructor. The Course ID includes your instructor's last name and some numbers. For example:
`instructor04298`
- A **student access code**, which should have come packaged with your textbook. For example:
`MMLST-TAROK-THOLE-PICON-SHRIK-PRAWN`

If you do not have a student access code, you can purchase access when you register.

If you are using a computer off campus (at home or work), you need “administrator rights” to your computer so you can install software. You also need to be connected to the internet to work in MyMathLab. *(If you're not sure your computer meets the system requirements, go to www.mymathlab.com/system.html, visit the MyMathLab Browser Check in your course, or contact Customer Technical Support at 1-800-677-6337).*

If you are using a computer on campus, the MyMathLab software is probably already installed. If you aren't sure, check with the lab administrator or your instructor.

Registering for your course

To register for your course in CourseCompass:

1. Open your web browser.

You can use Internet Explorer, Firefox, or Safari on either a PC or Macintosh. *If you normally use AOL to connect to the Internet, you need to minimize the AOL browser and then open IE, Firefox, or Safari.*

2. Go to www.coursecompass.com.
3. Click the **Register** button for students.



4. If you are registering for a new course, select **Get access to a new course**.


5. On the Product Selection page, enter the **course ID** your instructor gave you and click **Find Course**.

6. If you have a student access code, select **Access Code**.

7. Type your access code in the boxes. You can use either all uppercase or all lowercase letters.

Click **Next** at the bottom of the page after you have entered your code.

8. Review the License Agreement and Privacy Policy and then click **I Accept**.
9. On the Access Information Screen, you are asked whether you already have a Pearson Education Account.

If you have used other Pearson online courses, you may already have a login name and password. Select **Yes** to enter your login information.

If you have never registered for a Pearson online product, select **No**. Under **Create a Login Name**, enter your email address. If you do not want to use your email address, follow the guidelines for creating a login name. Under **Create a Password**, enter a password following the guidelines on the page. Be sure to write down your password.

***Create a Password**
 Strength: Great Your password cannot be the same as your login name.
 Create a password with at least eight characters containing at least one number and letter. [See acceptable characters.](#)

***Re-type Your Password**

If you aren't sure whether you have a Pearson account, select **Not Sure**. Enter your email address and click **Search**. If you have an account, your login information will be sent to your email address within a few moments. You can then change your selection to **Yes**, and enter your login name and password.

10. If you previously registered for a Pearson online course, your account information is already filled in on the Account Information page. Otherwise, enter the information in the boxes.

In the School Location section, select **United States** from the School Country drop-down menu. Enter your **school** zip code, and then select your school from the drop-down list.

If your school is not listed, scroll to the bottom of the drop-down list and select **Other**. Then enter your school name and city and select the state.



11. Select a security question and answer to ensure the privacy of your account. Click **Next**.

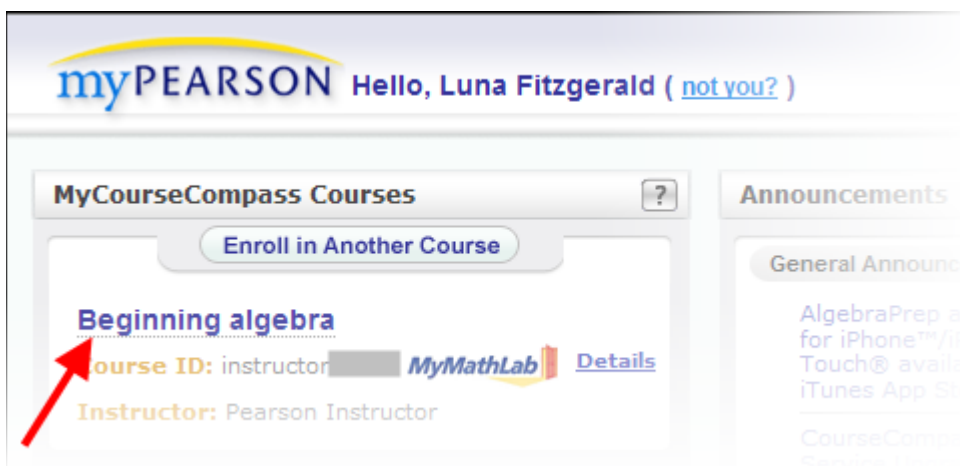
12. When your registration process is complete you will see a confirmation screen.


